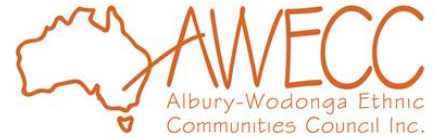

AWECC'S VISION:

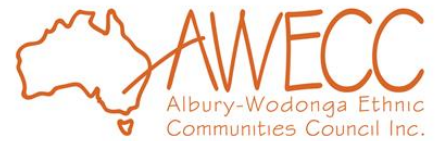
Please explain what your understanding is about AWECC's mission, vision, goals and objectives?
